**COLOUR - invoiced prices**  
 A4 £190 (or £200 full bleed); 1/2 £115; 1/4 [=A6] £65; 1/8 £40  
 • If prepaid: £4 less. Prepaid discounts 10% for 2 ads, 15% for 3 ads.  
 Colour ads - only on covers/inside covers, or exceptionally on colour insert page  
 - booking A4 colour position: prepaid, on 1st come, 1st served, basis

**MONO**  
 "Prepaid" is £4 less than invoiced; and 10% discount for 2 prepaid; prepaid year (3 issues) is over 15% less than 3 prepaid separately  
 • A4 ..... invoiced £73. Prepaid £69 ... year [x3, £207 -15%] £175  
 • 1/2 ..... invoiced £42. Prepaid £38 ... year [x3, £114 -15%] £96  
 • 1/4 [A6] ..... invoiced £25. Prepaid £21 ... year [x3, £63 -15%] £53  
 • 1/8 ..... invoiced £16. Prepaid £12 ... year [x3, £36 -15%] £30

## Members' News up to 200 words per item

 1/4, 300 • 1/2, 350 • A4, 450.

- your Reports, Dates, Festival Info, CD Info.
- Reviews: only as sent in by our Members, so please don't send CDs to editors
- ◇ don't count: heading [venue/start time] end [contact details]
- ◇ Photos: B&W high-res (300 dpi) welcome X not low-res eg copied from web X
- ◇ Word limits are for 1 item, you can send in more than 1 (so CD + news = 2 items).
- ◇ Festival & Workshops Diaries: same word limits for "More Details" section.
- ◇ CORRESPONDENTS usually 350 to 800 words [may vary, depends on local circulation/ads]

## ADS: SIZES (A4)

- Full bleed (= edge to edge); colour only max w 210, max h 297, +3 mm bleed
- A4 ..... max w 188, max h 275
- 1/2 across ↔ max w 188, max h 132
- 1/4 [A6] max w 92, max h 132
- 1/2 column ↑ max w 92, max h 268
- 1/8 ..... max w 92, max h 64
- Sizes include optional border
- Other: any combination of 1/8 boxes (4mm between boxes).

## ADS: EMAIL ads must be emailed: image or text

- ◇ email image: camera-ready - attach your tiff, jpeg, PDF - we can stretch to fit
- or ◇ email text: just email us the words; you can also attach 1 logo to be included; we will typeset, free, in our choice of typeface (as we often do for smaller clubs)

- ✓ We use: Mac OS 10.7.5, Adobe InDesign CS 6.
- ✓ Colour ads: you are advised to send us a printout so we can check colours.
- ✓ If B&W: pl convert colour to greyscale, & check that before sending.
- ✓ Jpeg ✓ Tiff
- ✓ PDF as high-definition 300dpi, text 600 dpi, fonts embedded; if B&W ad, send as greyscale.
- ✗ Word: "Word.doc" is not an image ..... so save Word as a PDF (→ Print → Save As PDF)
- ✗ complex adverts may appear differently, ask a professional designer to design & send them
